FROM THE DESK OF CODY MARINTZER

"Be sealed with the gift of the Holy Spirit" Pentecost and Confirmation.

In the Old Testament, God sent His spirit upon only a few chosen individuals. These were the Priests, Prophets, and Kings who were sent to lead God's people to Himself and guide them back when they strayed. The Apostles in the New Testament were the next group of people to receive His Spirit to then go forth proclaiming the Gospel message of Christ. This same spirit is now imparted upon all who receive the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation. We can see in the following what the Catechism teaches us on this:

1302 It is evident from its celebration that the effect of the sacrament of Confirmation is the special outpouring of the Holy Spirit as once granted to the apostles on the day of Pentecost.

1303 From this fact, Confirmation brings an increase and deepening of baptismal grace:

- it roots us more deeply in the divine filiation which makes us cry, "Abba! Father!"
- it unites us more firmly to Christ;
- it increases the gifts of the Holy Spirit in us;
- it renders our bond with the Church more perfect; 118
- it gives us a special strength of the Holy Spirit to spread and defend the faith by word and action as true witnesses of Christ, to confess the name of Christ boldly, and never to be ashamed of the Cross:

In this sealing, we see we are strengthened in the gifts of the Holy Spirit. These gifts are Wisdom, understanding, Counsel, Fortitude, Knowledge, Piety, Fear of the Lord.

Wisdom is both the knowledge of and judgment about "divine things" and the ability to judge and direct human affairs according to divine truth.

Understanding is penetrating insight into the very heart of things, especially those higher truths that are necessary for our eternal salvation—in effect, the ability to "see" God.

Counsel allows a man to be directed by God in matters necessary for his salvation.

Fortitude denotes a firmness of mind in doing good and in avoiding evil, particularly when it is difficult or dangerous to do so, and the confidence to overcome all obstacles, even deadly ones, by virtue of the assurance of everlasting life.

Knowledge is the ability to judge correctly about matters of faith and right action, so as to never wander from the straight path of justice.

Piety is, principally, revering God with filial affection, paying worship and duty to God, paying due duty to all men on account of their relationship to God, and honoring the saints and not contradicting Scripture.

Fear of the Lord is, in this context, "filial" or chaste fear whereby we revere God and avoid separating ourselves from him—as opposed to "servile" fear, whereby we fear punishment.

So, the sealing of the gift of the Holy Spirit is not a stopping point in our faith life, but is the beginning of living out our prophetic call to its full. It is receiving God's Spirit in such a way that we can now heroically go forth and proclaim the goodness of Christ to this fallen world.

"O Lord Jesus Christ, Who before ascending into heaven did promise to send the Holy Spirit to finish Your work in the souls of Your Apostles and Disciples, deign to grant the same Holy Spirit to me that He may perfect in my soul the work of Your grace and Your love. Grant me the Spirit of Wisdom that I may despise the perishable things of this world and aspire only after the things that are eternal, the Spirit of Understanding to enlighten my mind with the light of Your divine truth, the Spirit on Counsel that I may ever choose the surest way of pleasing God and gaining heaven, the Spirit of Fortitude, that I may bear my cross with You and that I may overcome with courage all the obstacles that oppose my salvation, the Spirit of Knowledge that I may know God and know myself and grow perfect in the science of the Saints, the Spirit of Piety that I may find the service of God sweet and amiable, the Spirit of Fear that I may be filled with a loving reverence towards God and may dread in any way to displease Him. Mark me, dear Lord with the sign of Your true disciples and animate me in all things with Your Spirit. Amen."
